

## Christ in Youth MOVE Conference

1. **Emergency Form** - You must have this form with you Thursday. The Christ in Youth Conference will not let you attend without this form! (Form is located in this pamphlet)
2. **Remaining Balance** - Please turn in your balance remaining (minus any deposit)
3. **Sleeping Bag & Pillow**
4. **Toiletries** - Everything you need to look pretty. 😊
5. **Money** - Bring Money for at least 4 meals.

Also, **don't forget** your Bible, notebook, special clothes (see dress code!), sporty clothes (we will be going to a couple of beaches in Southern California, and playing basketball throughout the week), and, as always, **bring a great attitude!** This trip is going to rock!

### Dress Code:

1. Shorts are fine
2. Girls can wear dresses or skirts...boys cannot
3. No *tight* shirts, sweaters, pants, shorts...both boys and girls
4. No spaghetti straps, bare mid-driffs or tank tops
5. No bikinis or 2 piece swimsuits
6. No short skirts or low-cut tops

### Special Rules from C.I.Y.

These rules are to be taken seriously and if any student breaks these rules they will be required to go home, which means a parent must come to Chapman University and pick up their student.

1. No Smoking, alcohol, or drugs
2. NO SEXUAL HARASSMENT
3. All screens on windows must remain on.
4. Do not throw anything from windows
5. No water balloons, water guns, shaving cream fights, air soft guns, or fireworks
6. No skateboards or rollerblades
7. No tampering with fire extinguishers and/or fire alarms
8. Must attend all services, sessions, devotions, D-groups, etc.
9. Must follow Dress Code
10. No guys in girls dorms and/or hallways, no girls in guys dorms and/or hallways
11. You are to be in dorms and have lights out by assigned times
12. Do not move any item of furniture or bedding from one room to another or from a lobby
