Children's Ministry Volunteering Opportunities Here at Northside:

Nursery/Toddler Program

Our nursery/toddler program offers care, fun, and attention for ages birth through 2½ years. Children get their first impressions of God at this young age. If you love holding babies or playing with toddlers, this is the ministry for you! The time commitment for this program is 1 service a month.

Preschool Program

Our preschool program is devoted to teaching children about Christ in a fun, interactive way. We offer worship time, snack time, lesson time, and more. Our preschool is open to children aged 2½ (potty trained) through kindergarten. Full training is provided and you may choose to serve as head teacher, assistant, or substitute for the following ages: 2, 3, 4, or 5. Commitment for this program is for 1 quarter (roughly 12 weekends) for either the Saturday 6 p.m. or Sunday 9 or 10:30 a.m. services.

Elementary Program

The elementary program at Northside focuses on teaching kids to study their Bibles and get out and serve in the community. With worship, game time, lessons, and small group time, kids can truly learn more about God and His plan for their lives. For this program, you can volunteer as a small group leader or assistant. Following large group lesson time and worship, these leaders meet with their age/gender group (for example, first grade girls, fourth grade boys, etc.) for a small group lesson time. This commitment is for a one quarter minimum for the Sunday 9 or 10:30 a.m. services. Other areas of need within the elementary program include greeters (15 minute commitment each weekend to help children and their parents feel welcome as they enter – needed for 9 and 10:30 services) and substitutes for small group leaders (as needed). We also need an assistant on Saturday nights to the large group lesson. This position includes helping the main teacher for the large group with games, worship, etc.

We have several exciting volunteer opportunities for all age groups. If something interests you, fill out the attached Children's Ministry application and background check consent form, along with the Area of Interest Form on the back panel of this brochure. Once your application is approved, we will contact you to schedule you in!



Are you technically minded?

We can use your help in our check-in kiosks. This position helps kids and their parents use our new electronic check-in system. Volunteers for this position need to commit to being in the Children's Center 15 minutes before service for the service that they are working. Service is flexible, but usually includes committing to coming to one service every weekend to help.

Do you love to shop?

Do you enjoy toys and interacting with people? We can use your help in the Souvenir Shop once a month if so! Volunteers come as they are available and come to the Souvenir Shop fifteen minutes before the end of service (roughly communion time if you attend the service). Volunteers are needed Saturday nights and both services on Sunday.

Looking for more activities outside of the weekend services?

Check out our Wednesday night "BreakOut!" program, Vacation Bible school or various other events during the year. "BreakOut!" meets at 6:30 p.m. until 8 p.m. on Wednesday nights and is a program from ages "K" through 6th grade. Leaders are needed for all grade groups, as well as several greeters and coordinators.
